



Victim Advocate Program

The FSU Victim Advocate Program, housed in the Dean of Students Department responds 24 hours a day to victims of sexual battery, relationship violence, stalking, physical battery, robbery and other crimes. The program serves FSU students who are victimized on or off campus, non-students who are victimized by FSU students, and any person who is victimized on the FSU campus. Advocates provide emotional support and practical assistance to victims. They make referrals to appropriate medical care, counseling and judicial/legal services, and will contact professors and family when requested. Sexual assault support groups are available. All services provided are free and confidential.
